## Application for Funding Hunger Program

- **PURPOSE AND BACKGROUND OF TWO CENTS A MEAL PROGRAM**
  - Purpose: The purpose of the Two Cents a Meal program is to meet the needs of hungry people and to address the systemic causes of hunger within the bounds of the West Jersey Presbytery, within our nation, and around the world.
  - Background: The West Jersey Presbytery adopted the 2 Cents a Meal Offering in 2001. Local churches participating in the program make funds available. Local churches keep a percentage of the money they raise, and then forward the remainder on to the Presbytery for disbursement.
- **ELIGIBILITY AND SELECTION CRITERIA**
  - Applications may be submitted by any organization within the bounds of the West Jersey Presbytery that is actively seeking to meet the needs of hungry people or addressing on the political, economic, and societal issues that cause hunger.
  - Applications will be considered if they meet the mission statement of the Presbyterian Hunger Program: *“To alleviate hunger and eliminate its causes.”*
  - Organizations not affiliated with a church that is a part of the Presbyterian Church (USA) should ask the session of the Presbyterian Church in their community to endorse their request.
  - Applications will be reviewed on a rolling, as received basis. Grants will be awarded only when funds are available.
  - The Presbytery's Hunger Action Enabler will evaluate all applications as to the quality of the program and the urgency of the need served by the program or ministry. She will then make recommendations to the Presbytery's Church and Society Committee, which will make the final determination regarding funding.
